Jobs: Expected to support more than 10,000 high-quality construction jobs throughout construction and hundreds of permanent positions upon completion.

Community Contribution: \$18 million over 20 years to the City of Cedar Rapids-owned Community Betterment Fund.

Our Approach to Conservation in Cedar Rapids

QTS builds data centers that consume no water for cooling once operational. In this closed-loop system, water is continually recirculated, which eliminates the need for a continuous supply of fresh water. This greatly reduces the impact on local resources **while safeguarding** a community's shared water supply.

We are committed to continual improvement of sustainability through research and innovation. Once operational, the Cedar Rapids campus is expected to save approximately 4 billion gallons of water annually, compared to data centers using evaporative cooling.

What are chillers?



QTS air-cooled chillers rely on recirculated water to remove heat from our equipment. Extremely efficient, these chillers do not consume water for cooling needs.

» Community Enrichment:

QTS is a proud sponsor of local Cedar Rapids events such as the 2026 Freedom Festival, the Linn-Mar Foundation's Mane Event, Women Lead Change: The Leadership Conference, the Tanager Golf Tournament: Teeing Up for Tanager and more.

» Reforestation Partnership:

Committing \$100,000 annually over five years (\$500,000 total) to the Cedar Rapids ReLeaf program and Monarch Research to plant 20,000 trees for private residents (4,000 trees per year).
